SHA Board Meeting Minutes of December 6, 2023

The SHA Board Meeting was held on ZOOM on Wednesday, December 6th, 2023. The meeting started at 7:02 pm. Board Members of SHA who were present were: Darryl Cross, Sheila Shattuck, Pam Gaston, Jeanne Kennedy, Lisa Rogers, Peggy Wilson, and Barb Houck. Roger Luth was absent. Other SHA members present were Sharna and Jeff Watson, and Gary George.

- SECRETARY The Secretary's minutes from November were approved. Sheila Shattuck made a motion for them to be accepted and Jeanne Kennedy seconded the motion. All were in favor.
- TREASURER The Equine Welfare Account has \$1723.19 in it. There is \$7760.31 in the checking account. We had \$345 deposited in November. Part of it was the money from new/renewal memberships received was \$270 plus a \$10 donation and a \$65 fee that was refunded for the table at the Festival of the Superstitions. There was \$26.40 paid for Stamps, \$75 to Sheila Shattuck, \$95.46 for Pony Tracks to Lisa Rogers for November and \$87.50 for October. All of this equals a total of \$349.36 that was deducted.

- MEMBERSHIP Barb Houck reported there are 68 memberships including honorary memberships which includes 95 individual members.
- BANNER Sheila Shattuck made a motion for a 6 foot by 3 foot banner to have "the logo and SHA" made for SHA. Pam Gaston made the motion to second it. All were in favor.
- CHRISTMAS DINNER Sheila
 Shattuck reported there were 53
 participants and 50 people showed
 up. There were 7 door prizes and
 plenty of good food and \$453 given
 to the Genesis Project. It was very
 successful.
- ROAD CLEANUP It was a success with 13 people coming and helping to clean up the roadway.
- **POLITICAL** Nothing for political.
- **EQUINE WELFARE** Sharna Watson stated the donkeys are looking better except for one.
- PARADE The Veteran's Day
 Parade was a big success, and we gave the crowd a good presentation and were well received. The Lost Dutchman Days' Parade is coming up. Pam Gaston will be entering the SHA parade unit tomorrow for the parade.
- **SHA STORE** Ann Adkins was absent.
- PETE DICHMAN Chip and Peggy have taken numerous loads of weeds to the dump.
- PROGRAM DIRECTOR –
- * Festival of the Superstitions could have been better especially with a banner.

- Membership meetings will possibly host the Buffalo Soldiers.
 We may also get a presenter from the museum.
- Sheila Shattuck made a motion to get a booth at the EVBCH, Pam Gaston seconded it. All were in favor.
- * EVBCH are going to be hosting the Fun Festival in January 20-21.
- Pam Gaston made some suggestions for a silent auction.
 The Board agreed. This would be for the Fun Festival as a vendor opportunity in January on the 20th and the 21st.
- * On February 9th, 10th and 11th there will be a television show, Best of America by Horseback, there will be numerous events including Darryl Cross and Chip Wilson being involved in a ride on Sunday. A day's event would be \$125 per day for riders, and \$425 for each double in one trailer or single in one trailer for \$475. This is a tremendous event for Apache Junction. Sheila Shattuck brought up the idea for a chicken dinner by our members at the TV Show for Sunday evening around 4:30. Pam Gaston made a motion for SHA to provide a chicken dinner for the show and Sheila Shattuck seconded it. All were in favor. Discussion ensued regarding members who do not ride could be a part of this.
- * Sheila Shattuck asked if we are getting more hitch rails prior to the Pony Express? Darryl stated there would be no hitch rails at the Post Office.

at the AJ Rodeo Grounds for the EVBCH Fun Festival


Auction Items Needed
