SHA Board Meeting Minutes of November 1, 2023

The SHA Board Meeting was held at Tina's on Wednesday, November 1st, 2023. The meeting started at 7:02 pm. Board Members of SHA who were present were: Darryl Cross, Sheila Shattuck, Pam Gaston, Jeanne Kennedy, Lisa Rogers, Peggy Wilson, Barb Houck and Roger Luth. Other SHA members were Chip Wilson, Director of Political and Equine Welfare, Lori Ewing, Sharna and Jeff Watson, Sylvia Drummond, Bev Dougherty, Cathy and Bob Diroff, and Phil Fedor.

- SECRETARY The Secretary's minutes from October were approved. Pam Gaston made a motion for them to be accepted and Roger Luth seconded the motion. All were in favor.
- TREASURER The Equine Welfare Account has \$1723.19 in it. There is \$7765.67 in the checking account. We had \$489 deposited in October. Part of it was the 50/50 for \$54, Bob Diroff gave back \$30, money from new/renewal memberships received was \$360. There was \$26.40 paid for Stamps, there was \$162.10 for chicken dinner. All of this equals a total of \$188.50 that was deducted.
- **MEMBERSHIP** Barb Houck reported there are 50 memberships,

- which includes 64 individual members.
- **POLITICAL** Nothing for political.
- EQUINE WELFARE Jeff Watson turned over the case of the donkeys to the police department and nothing has been heard about it.
- PARADE The SHA Parade Unit will be in the Veteran's Day AJ Parade. There will be four rehearsals at the AJ Rodeo Grounds on Oct. 17, 26th and November 1st. Practices start at 4 pm and the gates will open at 3:15 pm. The parade will begin on the 11th at 9 am.
- **SHA STORE** Ann Adkins was absent.
- PROGRAM DIRECTOR On the 9th and 10th of November, East Valley Back Country Horsemen are having a campout to work on segment 18 and 17. Sheila Shattuck asked SHA for assistance with meals. Pam Gaston made a motion to give financial assistance of \$75 and Roger Luth seconded it. All were in favor.
- At the museum, there will be a fund raiser for The Hope Women's Center for 40 ham dinners for families for Christmas. There will be tickets for sale at the museum store and they are \$20 a ticket. This Holiday Show will be on December 1st at 2 pm.
- On December 2nd, we are having the holiday party at the Handlebar.
 There will be a lighting of the tree and the light parade. More information will follow.
- Membership meetings will possibly host the Buffalo Soldiers.

- EVBCH are going to be hosting the Fun Festival in January.
- Pam Gaston made some suggestions for a silent auction and for a tack n stuff. That suggestion is tabled. This would be for the Fun Festival as a vendor opportunity in January.
- On February 9th, 10th and 11th there will be a television show, Best of America by Horseback, there will be numerous events including Darryl Cross and Chip Wilson being involved in a ride on Sunday. A day's event would be \$125 per day for riders, and \$425 for each double in one trailer or single in one trailer for \$475. This is a tremendous event for Apache Junction.




