

SHA Board Meeting Minutes of January 3, 2024

The SHA Board Meeting was held at Tina's on Wednesday, January **3rd, 2024**. The meeting started at 7:02 pm. Board Members of SHA who were present were: Darryl Cross, Pam Gaston, Jeanne Kennedy online, Peggy Wilson, Barb Houck and Roger Luth. Lisa Rogers and Sheila Shattuck were absent. Other SHA members were Chip Wilson, Director of Political and Equine Welfare, Sharna and Jeff Watson, Bev Dougherty, and Bob Diroff.

- SECRETARY The Secretary's minutes from December were approved. Pam Gaston made a motion for them to be accepted and Roger Luth seconded the motion. All were in favor.
- TREASURER The Equine Welfare Account has \$1723.19 in it. There is \$8016.44 in the checking account. We had \$453 + 190 membership + \$663 deposited in December. There was \$26.40 paid for Stamps, zelled for the Christmas Dinner \$274.01, \$10 AZ Corporation Report, \$2 AZ Sales Tax license, and \$95.46 for Pony Tracks to Lisa Rogers. All of this equals a total of \$407.87 that was deducted.
- MEMBERSHIP Barb reported there are 73 memberships which includes 103 individual members.

- **POLITICAL** Nothing for political.
- EQUINE WELFARE Nothing for Equine Welfare.
- PARADE We will be riding in the Lost Dutchman Days Parade in Division 1. A practice schedule will come out in the next two weeks.
- SHA STORE Ann Adkins was absent.
- PROGRAM DIRECTOR -
- \* EVBCH are going to be hosting the Fun Festival in January on the 20th and 21st AJ Rodeo Grounds.
- \* On February 9th, 10th and 11th there will be a television show, Best of America by Horseback, there will be numerous events including Darryl Cross and Chip Wilson being involved in a ride on Sunday. A day's event would be \$125 per day for riders, and \$425 for each double in one trailer or single in one trailer for \$475. This is a tremendous event for Apache Junction.
- \* Pam Gaston mentioned on behalf of Sheila Shattuck, the 150th commemorative rifle from MCSO for raffle. Discussion ensued. Roger Luth made a motion to purchase the rifle to be raffled at \$20/ticket with no more than 200 tickets to be sold.
  Peggy Wilson seconded it. All were in favor. Pam Gaston will purchase the rifle.
- GENERAL MEMBERSHIP There will be a SHA Membership Meeting at the Multi Gen Center at 7 pm.

Discussion ensued.

- Road Cleanup There will be a Road Cleanup at 8 am on March 9th.


Pam Gaston made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Roger Luth seconded it. All were in favor. The meeting was adjourned at 8:14 pm.
