We picked up 16 bags of trash, an old traffic cone, wire and miscellaneous items. Thanks to our members, Lost Dutchman Road looks great!





SHA Board Meeting Minutes of November 6, 2024

The SHA Board Meeting was held at Tina's on Wednesday, November 6th, 2024. The meeting started at 7:00 pm. Board Members of SHA who were present were: Darryl Cross, Pam Gaston, Jeanne Kennedy, Judy Hood, Lisa Rogers, Peggy Wilson, Jan Kramer, and Sheila Shattuck. Other SHA members were Bob Diroff, Chip Wilson, Director of the Political Committee, Ed Kramer, Jeff Watson, and Roger Luth.

- SECRETARY The Secretary's minutes from October were approved. Pam Gaston made a motion for the minutes to be accepted, and Peggy seconded it. All were in favor.
- TREASURER The checking account has \$7573.42. The Equine Welfare has \$1773.19. Income for the month and expenses were \$530 for membership income, total out was \$2406.19 total, Jackie Cross was reimbursed for membership cards - \$7.25, \$40 for room rental, \$100 to Pam Gaston for the EVBCH Festival, stamps were \$32.85, Pony Tracks - Lisa \$242.35, there was \$318.34 to Pam Gaston for the Watch Party, \$149 for Tent for Sheila Shattuck, and Sharna Watson - pistol for the gun raffle was \$1516.30.

- MEMBERSHIP Jan Kramer reported there are thirty single memberships, twenty six family memberships and five honorary memberships.
- POLITICAL There is a proposition to accept the road tax so road maintenance will be kept up. The school bond did not pass. The City of AJ is working on accessory dwelling units to be permanently built for rent by property owners.
- EQUINE WELFARE We received three horses today that were in distress - malnourished. Currently, SHA has the animals at the AJ Rodeo Grounds. We also need to contact a veterinarian to check them over. We need to decide who is going to take care of the animals. We need to check for liability issues also, which includes insurance. Chip Wilson handed out a copy of an equine surrender agreement. Sheila Shattuck said she would take this to the owner who surrendered the animals and have her sign them. It was agreed the animals would be looked at by Dr. Harvey. Sheila Shattuck suggested two pens out by themselves away from the arena and other pens, but water would be an issue. Discussion ensued regarding placement of hoses and quarantine plus pallets for feed/hay. Pam Gaston made a motion for \$1200 to be earmarked for these three horses for possible farrier, feed, insurance, and vet care. Sheila Shattuck seconded it. All were in favor. Chip Wilson suggested that one person have the key and then contact different people. There are three keys - Sheila Shattuck, Roger Luth, and Chip Wilson. Discussion

- ensued regarding a combo lock instead of a key that would be convenient and a hose adapter. Currently, Sheila Shattuck is the "Care Giver".
- PARADE No participation in the Veteran's Day Parade.
- FESTIVAL OF THE SUPERSTITION -This has been cancelled.
- **STORE DIRECTOR** Nothing for Store Director.
- AJ RODEO GROUNDS There is nothing for the AJ Rodeo Grounds other than infrastructure building.
- PROGRAM DIRECTOR Sheila Shattuck stated we have Horsey Bingo on Nov 17th, which includes: 12 pm gates open, 12:15 rider registration, 1 pm ride, 3-3:15 non-rider registration, 3:30 pm begin Horsey Bingo, eat at 4:45 for \$14.50 at the food truck for pulled pork and two sides. There will be an SHA Christmas Party at the Handlebar on December 7th, dinner at 5 pm.... parade at 7 pm - \$15 per meal – door prizes and 50/50. There is a possibility of riding in the parade in a wagon. On January 11th, if possible, we will have a breakfast ride and then Jan 25/26 includes the burro racing.... EVBCH FESTIVAL where we will have a booth for silent auction/ membership/Pony Express. Those three booths will need people to run them. On Feb. 21/22/23 we will have a booth at Lost Dutchman Days, and we will need workers. On March 1st, we will have the Pony Express. It is going to be a busy season.


